

Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19)

The PEAK School believes in keeping families updated and is closely monitoring information related to Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Coronaviruses are a large family of viruses, some causing respiratory illness in people. Signs and symptoms, similar to the common cold or the flu, include a runny nose, cough, sore throat, fever, and general feeling of being unwell. If we are alerted that any type of community exposure has occurred in Coconino County, we will immediately follow all protocols set forth by the Coconino County Health Department.

According to the Center for Disease Control (CDC), "For the general American public, who are unlikely to be exposed to this virus at this time, the immediate health risk from COVID-19 is considered low." However, PEAK will continue to monitor the situation and will update families regarding changes to practices in the event that the risk assessment changes. Additionally, it is currently flu and respiratory disease season in Arizona, and with that in mind, we remind all to take the following precautions, no matter what time of year it is, to keep our schools healthy:

- Get a flu shot if possible
- Wash hands frequently with soap and water for a minimum of 20 seconds
- Cover your cough and sneezes with a tissue and immediately wash your hands
- Keep common area surfaces clean with disinfecting wipes
- Stay home if feeling ill
- Avoid touching eyes, nose, and mouth

People who have the following symptoms need to stay home:

- Frequent/persistent cough
- Respiratory symptoms
- Vomiting or diarrhea
- Rash and fever or a rash that is contagious
