

Dear Kindergarten Families,

It's hard to believe there is just one month of school left in the year. We have big plans this month so please make sure to send your child to school with a good night's sleep and breakfast. It really helps them focus and get the most out of their school day.

In language arts this month, we will work on learning the rest of the 40 kindergarten sight words and will regularly use them in sentences. We will also work on explanatory writing, with help. In math, we will review telling time to the hour, measuring in inches, 2D and 3D shapes, identifying pennies, nickels, dimes and quarters, adding fluently within 5, counting to 100, and solving word problems. In science, we will be observing caterpillars go through their life cycle. We expect them to emerge as butterflies before the end of school. We will also be working on learning about parts of plants, what plants need to grow, and the plant life cycle. In history/geography we will review and learn facts about each of the 7 continents. Whew! We are going to have tired brains!

Our Bearizona Field Trip will be on Tuesday, May 7th. We will also be going to Francis Short Pond on Tuesday, May 21st with Willow Bend Environmental Education Center. Please return the permission slip as soon as possible. Kindergarten graduation on the last day of school, May 30th, at 10am.

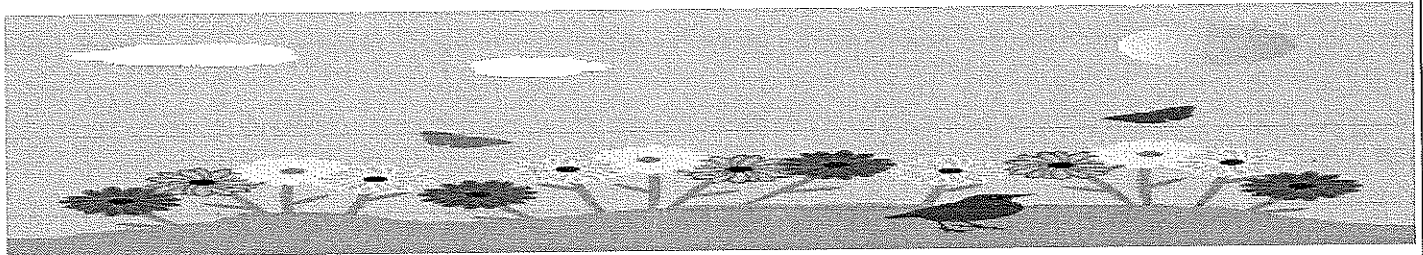

Our class always needs donations! We are in need of pencils, erasers, and disinfectant wipes (especially with allergies and illnesses!).

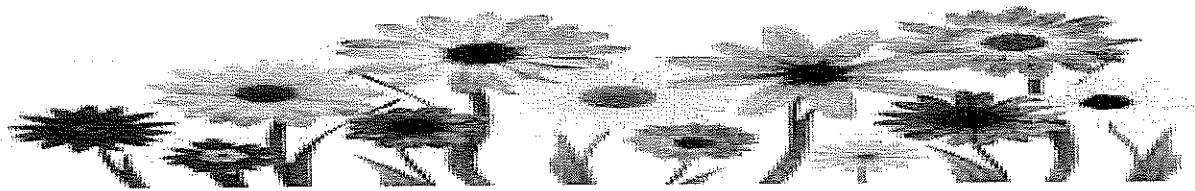

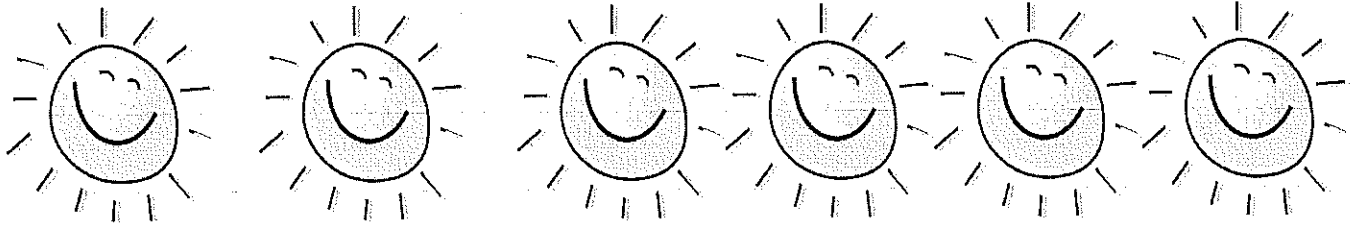

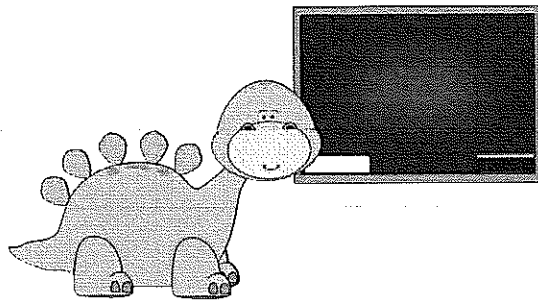
