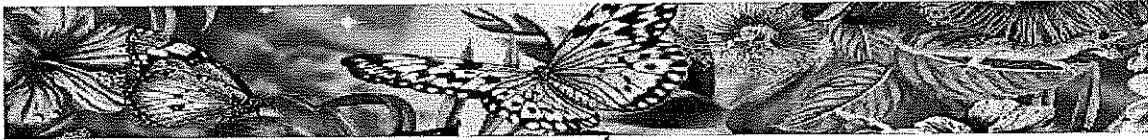
In language arts this month, we will work on learning the rest of the 40 kindergarten sight words and will regularly use them in sentences. We will also work on writing a personal narrative with help. In math, we will review telling time to the hour, measuring in inches, 2D and 3D shapes, identifying pennies, nickels, dimes and quarters, adding fluently within 5, counting to 100, and solving word problems. In science, we have been observing our caterpillars that are currently in the chrysalis stage. We expect them to emerge as butterflies during the first week of May. We will also be working on learning about parts of plants, what plants need to grow, and the plant life cycle. In history/geography we will review and learn facts about each of the 7 continents. Whew! We are going to have tired brains!

Our Bearizona Field Trip will be on Tuesday, May 15<sup>th</sup>. Thank you to the parents who have already signed up to drive. Please note on the calendar that we have a Spring Music Performance at Sinagua Middle School on May 23<sup>rd</sup> and will have Kindergarten graduation and a potluck on the last day of school, May 31<sup>st</sup>, at 10am.

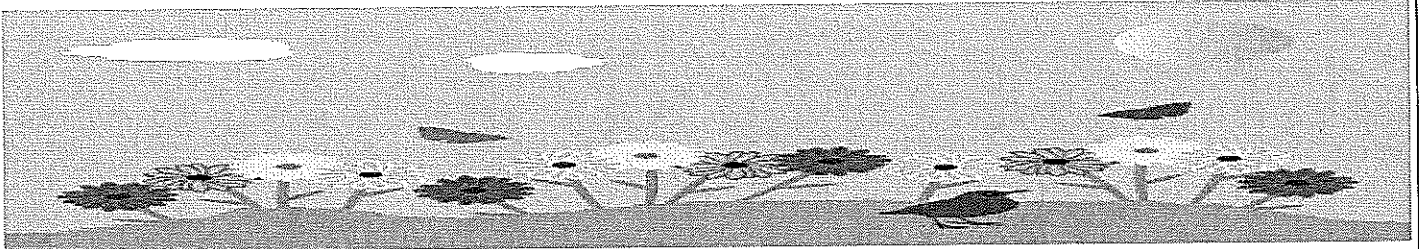

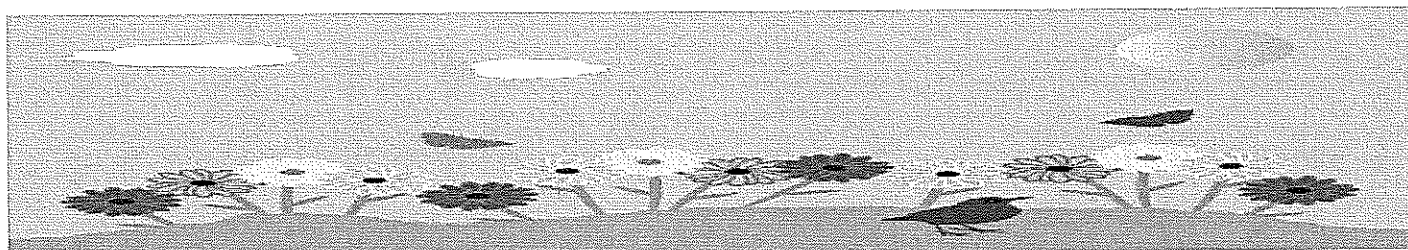

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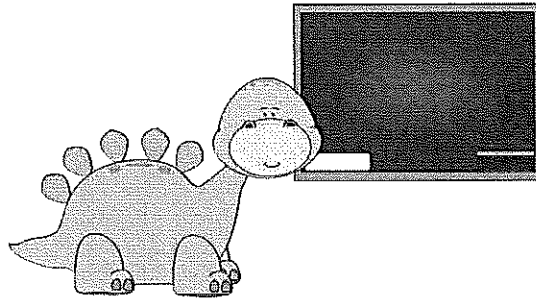
