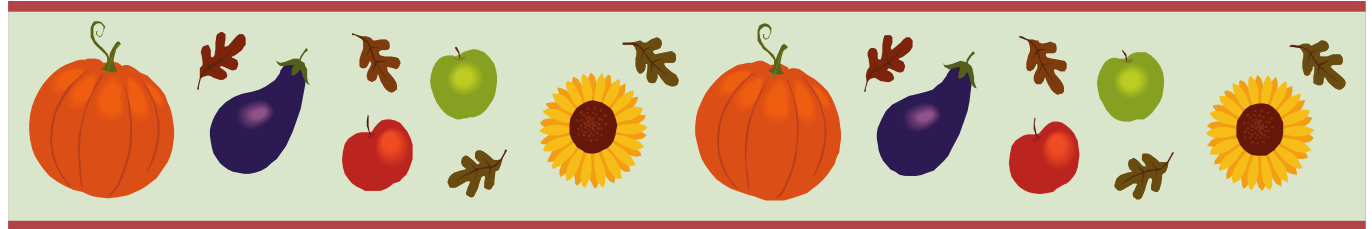
We will be having a Fall class party on October 29th of this month. I will send home more information as the date gets closer. Have a great month!

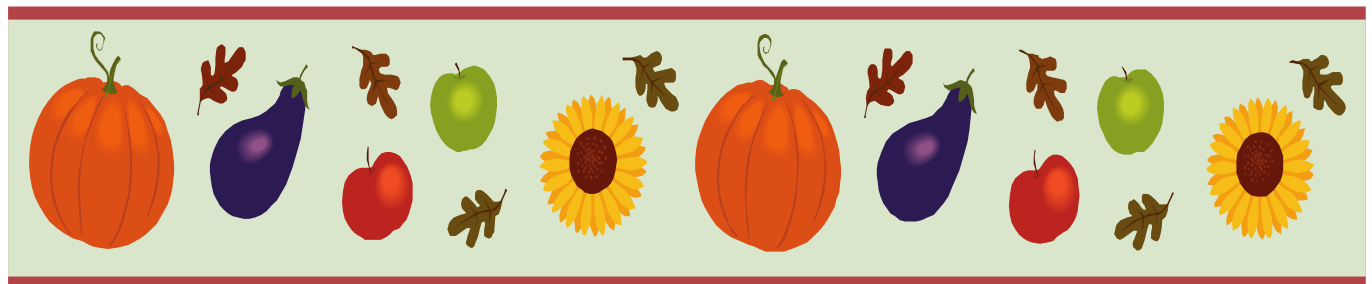
